



General Information for Level 1, 2, and 3 Clinics

What to bring:

- Level 1 participants should have a Parelli rope halter, 12' lead, carrot stick with a savvy string, and possibly a saddle. Level 2 should have all the above plus a natural hackamore and 22' lead. (If you don't have a hackamore, you can use your halter and 12' line). Advancing Level 2, may ride in a bridle. Level 3, all the above plus 45' line.
- Equines should have their own hay, grain, feed and if wanted, shavings.
- Extra bucket for feeding grain and water may be needed.

Hours and breaks:

- Start time each day will be 10am. The morning session will go from 10:00-12:30 and the afternoon session will go from 1:30-4:00. There will also be short breaks when needed.

Concessions:

- Coffee, fruit, and danish will be available each morning during clinics.
- Please bring your own lunch.
- Bring a chair if auditing, sunscreen, snacks, drinks, etc.

Check in:

- We will check in Participants and Auditors starting at 9:00am on Saturday morning. You will need to sign liability release forms. All horses should be up to date on all vaccines.

Cancellations:

- There will be NO REFUNDS. If there is a special circumstance only, there will be a credit for the next upcoming clinic or lesson.

FUN:

- Be ready, we will have fun. Learning is not usually fun, but I will try my hardest to bring FUN into what we are doing. Most people that own horses don't have fun, lets not go there!
