*No dogs or stallions allowed.

*If you would like to try a Parelli saddle, please email me a time to set up before or after the workshops. Roper, Natural Performer, Fluidity and Super Wide Fluidity are available.

*If it rains, we will reschedule.

What to bring:

*L1 Participants should have a Parelli rope halter, 12' lead, carrot stick with a savvy string,. L2 should have all the above plus a natural Hackamore or snaffle, saddle and 22' lead. Level 3, all above plus 45' line.

*Equines should have their own hay, grain, feed and if wanted, Shavings.

*Extra bucket for feeding grain and water may be needed.

Hours and breaks:

*Start time each day will be 9am. Morning session will go from 9-12pm and afternoon session will go from 1:00-4 pm. There will also be short breaks when needed.

Concessions:

*Coffee, fruit, and danish will be available each morning during clinics.

*Bring your own lunch or check with host on food locations.

Check in:

*We will check in Participants and Auditors starting at 8am on Saturday morning. You will need to sign a facility liability release form. All horses should be up to date on all vaccines.
